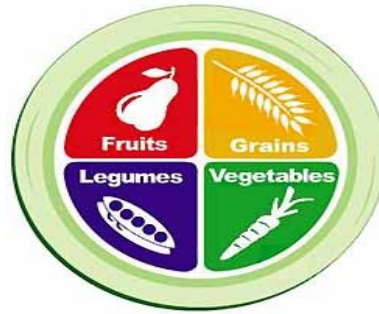

Campers are grouped according to grade level to ensure a low counselor to camper ratio. Camp activities include arts and crafts, physical activities and games, character development, guest speakers, weekly field trips, and swimming activities.

Ages

Our camp is for children in grades K-5. That is grade as of August 2019.

Day Camp Hours

Summer Day Camp will run Monday through Friday from 8:00 am until 3:00 pm daily. If children are NOT picked up by 3:30 authorities will be contacted.

Location

Day camp will be held at the Recreation center at the Fannin County Park. The facilities available to us will be the gymnasium, football fields, baseball fields, soccer fields, playgrounds and classrooms for board games and arts & crafts and much more. We will have a counselor at the rec center site at 7:30 am for an early drop off. Please let us know at registration if you will be needing this service.

Limitations

There is a limit on the number of children we can serve per session. Early registration and payment will hold your spot. You are not considered registered until payment is made and paperwork completed and turned in!

Meals

Breakfast and lunch are provided daily at no charge!
