

The idea of an After School Program has long been in the minds of many Fannin county residents. There is such a need in the community for working parents to entrust their children once school lets out.

Our story begins with two visions coming together to form this After school program for the Fannin County Recreation Department. Once the plans began being discussed, we never looked back.

Activities

Activities will include first and foremost, homework help. The first 30 minutes of the day will be devoted to homework within age groups while eating snacks.

Snacks are provided this year.

Other activities will include free play, outdoor play, organized activities indoors and out, games, arts and crafts, community service projects, STEM & STEAM activities, and basic life skills and much more.

“Rebel Days”

Periodically we will offer “Rebel Days” during school breaks for the children who need care. . We will have planned events or take fieldtrips for an additional fee during these days.

A schedule of Rebel days will be posted.

Program Staff

The After School Program is designed to provide quality care for your child. All staff are qualified and have had years of experience with children. We are all trained in current CPR and first aid, and mandated reporter trained. The afternoon is planned in groups with the supervision of mom’s, Fannin county teacher’s and college counselors. Many of the counselors are achieving their teaching degrees. We understand that children sit all day in school and we base our program on getting the children moving and involved in different activities. We provide snack daily as well as a well balanced schedule.

The group will be split into groups according to age. Each group will be assigned a counselor. They will be accompanied by staff at all times. Groups will rotate between sessions throughout the afternoon.
