



CLOSING

OPENING REGULAR MEETING

Chairman Helton called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

Present in meeting were Chairman Helton, Post One Commissioner Earl Johnson and Post Two Commissioner Glenn Patterson and County Attorney Lynn D. Doss.

The Invocation was led by Commissioner Glenn Patterson and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Earl Johnson.

Chairman Helton stated Ms. Walker was not present due to attending required Mandated Training for Clerks. Ms. Doss was appointed to take the minutes.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Chairman Helton made Motion first to approve the minutes of the August 27, 2019 Regular Meeting. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.
