**OPENING REGULAR MEETING**

Chairman Hensley called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Item #1: Invocation was led by Commissioner Glenn Patterson. Pledge was led by Commissioner Earl Johnson.

Chairman Hensley removed Item #7 due to being postponed by the General Assembly.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

Item #2: Chairman Hensley asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the March 9th, 2021 Regular Scheduled Meeting. Motion made first by Commissioner Patterson. Motion made second by Chairman Hensley. Motion passed unanimously with Commissioner Johnson abstaining.

Item #3: Variance Request from John B. and Patricia Sundry to build proposed garage 15 feet from the edge and 24 feet from the centerline of Aska Forest Trail in Aska Highlands. No party was present to oppose the variance. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approve the variance. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed with Commissioner Johnson abstaining.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Item #4: Variance Request from Floyd Scott & Angela Suit to build a metal building 32 feet from the edge and 41 feet from the centerline of Pan Will Road. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approve the variance request. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed with Commissioner Johnson abstaining.

Item #5: EMA Director, Robert Graham presented to the Board the Debris Removal Plan. Chairman Hensley asked for a motion to approve the plan. Motion made first by Commissioner Patterson. Motion made second by Chairman Hensley. Motion passed with Commissioner Johnson abstaining.

Mr. Graham also presented to the Board the proposal for the cost of having Liquid Springs added to the new ambulance. Mr. Graham stated these would make a difference in the ability to load the stretchers into the ambulance. Mr. Graham stated the full cost would be \$12,300.00. Chairman Hensley asked for a motion to approve the cost of adding liquid springs to the new ambulance. Motion made first by Commissioner Patterson. Motion made second by Chairman Hensley. Motion passed with Commissioner Johnson abstaining.

Item #6: Public Works Director, Zack Ratcliff presented to the Board the FY 2021 LMIG Safety Action Plan from the Georgia Department of Transportation. Mr. Ratcliff stated this is to improve the safety of our county roads and will be State funded with no project exceeding \$350,000. The County would match at 3% which would be a total of \$105,000. After discussions of the project and funding, Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approve. Commissioner Patterson made a motion second. Motion passed with Commissioner Johnson abstaining.

The following individuals approached the Board with public commentary: Brian Pritchard, Donna Thompson, Debbie Holcomb and Julie Wooten.

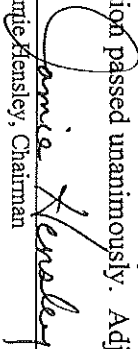
