OPENING REGULAR MEETING

Chairman Hensley called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Present in meeting were Chairman Jamie Hensley, Post One Commissioner Johnny Searce, Post Two Commissioner Glenn Patterson, County Attorney Lynn D. Doss, & County Clerk Sherri L. Walker.

Item #1: Invocation was led by John Chastain. Pledge was led by Commissioner Searce.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Item #2: Chairman Hensley made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 11th, 2021 Work Session & May 11th, 2021 Regular Scheduled Board of Commissioners Meeting. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.

Item #3: Chairman Hensley stated this item of business being the award of the Bid Proposals for the Radio Console System for the Fannin County 911 would be awarded at the next regular scheduled meeting of June 8th.

NEW BUSINESS

Item #4: Request for easement for ingress and egress from Anthony Falls. Mr. Falls requested a permanent easement to access property behind Fire Station 13 on Aska Road. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approve the request for easement. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.

Item #5: Moratorium on the issuance of any Special Event License for Alcoholic Beverages in the unincorporated area of Fannin County until the amendment of the Alcohol License Ordinance is completed. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to place a 30 day moratorium on the Special Event License Permit until the ordinance is amended. The moratorium will take effect until the next regular scheduled meeting of June 22nd to revisit the issue. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Hensley made a motion first to come out of Executive Session. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Hensley stated there had been no decision made in Executive Session.

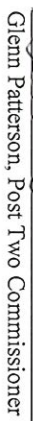
CLOSING
