**OPENING OF REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING**

Present in meeting were Chairman Jamie Hensley, Post One Commissioner Johnny Searce, Post Two Commissioner Glenn Patterson, County Attorney Lynn D. Doss, & County Clerk Sherri L. Walker.

Item #1: Invocation was led by Commissioner Patterson. Pledge was led by Commissioner Searce.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Item #1: Board Action on Resolution to set Qualifying Fees for 2022 – Chairman Hensley made a motion first to set Qualifying Fees for 2022. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.

Item #2: Board Action on Sites Road – Chairman Hensley stated the road being Sites Road was voted on in the last Regular Scheduled Board Meeting to be accepted into the Fannin County Road list but was since known to be a road in which the City of Blue Ridge maintains and is on their list of streets. Therefore, Chairman Hensley made a motion first to rescind the motion made on January 11<sup>th</sup> to accept 300 feet of Sites Road into the Fannin County Road List. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.

Item #3: Public Works Director Zack Ratcliff approached the Board seeking permission to place out the bid package for the repairs of Newport Bridge. Mr. Ratcliff stated this was an emergency repair in order to get the bridge opened back up. Mr. Ratcliff stated he would be asking for a 60 day completion time. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approve the bid package. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Ratcliff also approached the Board regarding the repairs of a 2000 Sterling Dump truck with snowplow. Mr. Ratcliff stated the repair would be \$10,000. This would be paid for with SPLOST. Chairman Hensley asked for a motion to approve the purchase. Motion made first by Commissioner Patterson. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Ratcliff also presented the contract with Compass Mineral for the bulk de-icing salt. The contract would be for three tons of salt product. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approve the contract. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.
