**OPENING OF REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING:**

Present in meeting were Chairman Jamie Hensley, Post One Commissioner Johnny Searce, Post Two Commissioner Glenn Patterson, County Attorney Lynn D. Doss, & County Clerk Sherri L. Walker was not present due to training. County Attorney Lynn Doss filled in.

Item #1: Invocation was led by Post Two Commissioner Glenn Patterson Pledge was led by Commissioner Johnny Searce.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Item #2: Approve minutes of the January 25th, 2022 Regular Scheduled Meeting. Motion made first by Chairman Hensley to approve the minutes of the January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Regular Scheduled Meeting. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.

Item #3: Board action/discussion on bids for Camera system at the Recreation Center. Chairman Hensley asked for a motion to table until next regular scheduled meeting until each bidder could get prices on different camera equipment. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Item #6: Fannin County Sheriff's Office – X-ray Body Scanner for Detention Center. Sheriff Kirby approached the Board regarding the purchase of the body scanner. Sheriff Kirby stated he anticipated a cost of \$150,000 and he wanted to get some bids for the equipment and check on State contracts. Sheriff Kirby stated he would come back to the Board once he has more information on the State contract.

Item#7: Fannin County Fire Chief Larry Thomas – Property for Fire Station #5. Chief Larry Thomas approached the Board regarding purchasing additional 1.98 acres for \$12,000 on Madola Road for Fire Station #5. Purchasing the extra property would keep the building out of the flood plane. Chief Thomas stated this would be paid for out of SPLOST. Chairman Hensley asked for a motion to purchase the additional 1.98 acres for fire station. Motion made motion first by Commissioner Searce. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.

Chief Thomas also approached the Board regarding replacing the doors at Fire Station #3. Chief Thomas stated the doors have been damaged and currently they are out of line; and this creates a risk not being able to open and close the doors. Total cost to replace the doors would be \$5,912.00. This would be paid for out of SPLOST. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approach the purchase of the doors. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.

Item #8: Board action on amendment of the July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Board minutes as to the adoption of county road to be reflected as Hidden Cove Road and not being Trails Ends. Chairman Hensley asked for a motion to amend the minutes of July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021 to reflect the road being Hidden Cove off of Trails End. Motion made first by Commissioner Searce. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.
