**OPENING OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING:**

The Special Called Meeting was conducted at the Fannin County Performing Arts Center and was combined with the Fannin County Board of Education Special Called Meeting. Also present was Speaker of the House David Ralston.

Invocation was led by Rev. Scott Mathis and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Dr. Michael Gwatney.

The Fannin County Board of Education called their meeting to order at 11:00 a.m. The Fannin County Board of Commissioners called their meeting to order at 11:01 a.m.

The Fannin County Board of Education stated the purpose of the Special Called Meeting was for Real Estate.


Dr. Michael Gwatney stated the Real Estate would be for the property at 2290 E. First Street to be given to the Fannin County Board of Commissioners to construct a new library for the citizens of the community. County Attorney Lynn Doss briefly highlighted the Real Estate Purchase Contract. Dr. Gwatney made the recommendation and asked for a motion. First motion made by Terry Bramlett. Second motion made by Chad Galloway. Motion passed unanimously.

Next, Chairman Hensley made a motion first to accept the recommendation of receiving the property at 2290 E. First Street to construct a new library for the citizens of Fannin County. Motion made second by Commissioner Glenn Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.



Next, Speaker David Ralston elaborated on the cooperative efforts of both Boards working on this together and commended both Boards for their efforts and hard work. Speaker Ralston stated this has been ongoing for many years. Speaker Ralston also stated the State of Georgia funds of \$2.6 million would be given toward the library with the match of \$1.3 million.

Terry Bramlett with the Fannin County Board of Education made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion made second by Dr. Michael Gwatney. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Hensley with the Fannin County Board of Commissioners asked for a motion to adjourn. Motion made first by Commissioner Patterson. Motion made second by Commissioner Searce. Motion passed unanimously.
