

Fannin County Board of Commissioners Regular Scheduled Meeting April 11th, 2023 @ 6:00 p.m. Jury Assembly Room Third Floor

#### OPENING OF REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING:

Present in meeting were Chairman Jamie Hensley, Post One Commissioner Johnny Scearce, Post Two Commissioner Glenn Patterson, County Clerk Sherri L. Walker & County Attorney Lynn D. Doss.

Item #1: Invocation was led by Commissioner Patterson. Pledge was led by Commissioner Scearce.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Item #2: Board approval of the minutes from the March 28th, 2023 Regular Scheduled Meeting. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approve the minutes of the March 28th, 2023 meeting. Motion made second by Commissioner Scearce. Motion passed unanimously.

Items #3: Board Discussion/Action on Senior Citizen Flooring Replacement (Tabled from March 28th, 2023). After discussion on the items tabled, Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approve the quote from North Georgia Concrete Staining, LLC in the amount of \$20,000.00 to be paid from General Fund. Motion made second by Commissioner Scearce. Motion passed unanimously. (Insurance Claim)

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Item #4: Board Discussion/Action on the Fannin County Board of Health – Proposed Fee Schedule. Mr. Shannon Bradburn approached the Board with the new Environmental Health Services Fee Scheduled which consisted of some increases while some of the other fees were decreased. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to approve the fee schedule. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.

Item#5: Board Discussion/Action on Public Works Director Zack Ratcliff – Purchase of Equipment. Mr. Ratcliff approached the Board regarding purchasing a Mower Max Boom with 24ft Boom Arm with 60 in. Rotary Deck with hydraulic controlled deck door and 90 degrees swivel. The amount of the equipment would be \$229,110.75. Chairman Hensley asked for a motion to approve the purchase of the equipment in the amount of \$229,110.75 with SPLOST. Motion made first by Commissioner Patterson. Motion made second by Commissioner Scearce. Motion passed unanimously.

Item #6: Board Discussion/Action on Fannin County Health Department Roof Replacement. Chairman Hensley stated the roof on the Fannin County Health Department would need to be replaced. This would be an insurance claim and would be reimbursed by insurance minus the deductible. Chairman Hensley stated there were three quotes as follows: Roof It Forward in the amount of \$39,600.00, Rainman Roofing in the amount of \$39,775.00 & Southeast Roofing & Contracting, LLC in the amount of \$39,900.00. After discussion, Chairman Hensley asked for a motion to approve the quote from Roof It Forward in the amount of \$39,600.00. Motion made first by Commissioner Scearce. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.

Item #7: Board Discussion/Action on Resolution of The Board of Commissioners of Fannin County Declaring the Results of an Election Held on March 21, 2023 and Certificate of Election Superintendent. Chairman Hensley made a motion first to adopt the Resolution. Motion made second by Commissioner Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.

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# RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FANNIN COUNTY DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 21, 2023 AND

#### CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION SUPERINTENDENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Fannin County (the "Board of Commissioners"), adopted a resolution on January 24, 2023, to reimpose, levy, and collect a special county one percent sales and use tax and to authorize the issuance of general obligation debt of Fannin County (the "County"), conditioned upon approval by a majority of the qualified voters residing within the County voting in a referendum thereon to be held on March 21, 2023; and

WHEREAS, a copy of said resolution was delivered to the Chairman of the Board of Registrations and Elections of Fannin County, as Election Superintendent for the County (the "Election Superintendent"), who issued a call for the election; and

WHEREAS, the Election Superintendent caused notice of said election to be published in the newspaper published in the County in which sheriff's advertisements for the County are published, notifying the qualified voters of the County that on March 21, 2023, an election would be held (the "Election"), said notice having been published for the time and in the manner and containing the specifications and information required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Election was held on March 21, 2023, in accordance with said resolution, call, and notice, and the several managers of the election brought in the returns from the Election as required by law and these officers calling the Election, in the presence of and together with the several managers, consolidated the returns and the results thereof; and

WHEREAS, the consolidated returns found the results of the Election to be as follows:

#### 1% SPLOST ELECTION

Shall a special one percent sales and use tax be imposed in the special district of Fannin County for a period of time not to exceed 6 Years and for the raising of an estimated amount of \$56,000,000.00 for the purpose of funding: (1) the following projects of Fannin County: (i) Maintenance, Repair and Construction of roads, streets, bridges and sidewalks & Public Works Equipment - 55%; (ii) Water Projects Countywide - 7%; (iii) Capital Outlay/ Parking - 9%; (iv) Recreation Equipment/Facilities - 6.9%; and (v) Public Safety Facilities / Public Service Equipment - 8.5%; (2) the following projects of the City of Blue Ridge: (i) Maintenance, Repair and Construction of Roads, Drainage & Sidewalks - 5.36%; (ii) Water & Sewer upgrades & Capital Outlay - 1.79%; and (iii) Recreation Facilities and Improvements - 0.35%; and (3) the following projects of the City of McCaysville: (i) Capital Outlay for Roads, Streets, Bridges and City Park, including, but not limited to construction, repair, maintenance, and equipment for the same, which purposes may include sidewalks and bicycle paths - 2.5%; (ii) Capital Outlay, water and sewer, utility equipment and facilities - 2.1%; and (iii) Public safety facilities and public service Equipment - 1.5%?

If imposition of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of Fannin County, Georgia in the principal amount of \$49,000,000.00 for the purposes of funding all or a portion of any of the Projects."

WHEREAS, a copy of the Election Summary Report and Consolidated Returns filed by the Election Superintendent with the office of the Secretary of State and the Commissioner of the Georgia Department of Revenue is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the qualified voters of the County voting in the Election voted in favor of the question which gives approval for the reimposition of the special county one percent sales and use tax and the issuance of general obligation debt of the County in the principal amount not to exceed \$49,000,000.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND CERTIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. To the extent that the Board of Commissioners may be considered as one of the officers ordering the Election under the provisions of Official Code of Georgia Annotated § 38-82-2, or any other provisions of law which may be deemed applicable, the Board of Commissioners does hereby declare the results of the Election to be in favor of the question set forth above, which constitutes approval of the reimposition of the special county one percent sales and use tax and of the issuance of general obligation debt of the County in the principal amount not to exceed \$49,000,000.
- 2. The consolidated returns of the Election and this resolution shall be entered upon the minutes of this meeting of the Board of Commissioners.
- 3. The Election Superintendent has prepared copies of the consolidated returns and certified and filed the same as required by law. The Election Superintendent has complied with all other applicable provisions of the Georgia Election Code.
- 4. The issuance of general obligation debt having been duly approved, ratified and confirmed, statutory notice that effect shall be served upon the District Attorney of the Appalachian Judicial Circuit of Georgia, and such notice shall be executed on behalf of the Board of Education by its Chairman and that said District Attorney may, as provided by law, institute proceedings to have such general obligation debt validated.
