

INVITATION TO BID

PART 1. GENERAL

1.1 SEALED BIDS:

Fannin Co. Water Authority will construct a **High Country Crossing Line Extension**. Sealed bids for materials will be received until **Monday, November 6, 2023 at 2:00 PM**. Bids must be submitted electronically at QuestCDN.com. No paper submissions will be allowed. Any proposal received after said time and date will not be considered by the Owner. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

1.2 SCOPE OF WORK:

Vendor to supply waterworks materials directly to the Authority. Materials to include 8” and 6” PVC C900 DR18 pipe, 2” PVC SDR 13.5 pipe, fire hydrants, gate valves, fittings, service components, and any other miscellaneous parts necessary for the Authority to complete the project. Funding provided in part or whole by SPLOST.
